The Colonial Club's transportation service is designed to help bring people to & from the Adult Day Center or to our noon congregate meal site. NUTRITION

One of the most requested services offered at Colonial Club is the home-delivered meal program. Recipients must be home-bound and pass an assessment, usually conducted by a case manager. Bernard had been a home-delivered meal participant up until his death in 2018. His daughters found the program to be invaluable as it gave them reassurance knowing their parents were receiving such support. Following his passing, Bernard's family made a donation to both the nutrition and case management programs.





VOLUNTEERS



ADULT DAY CARE

Bobbie is one of the younger participants in the Adult Day Center. He has been coming for 3 years. When Bobbie was asked about the Adult Day Center he says it is his whole point of living. When he first came he was worried but that changed once he got to talking with everyone. Bobbie says this about the Day Center: "I love the socialization and excitement. Everyone sees the goodness in me and I see it in them. No one judges by color or age. I have 20 some Mothers at the Adult Day Center. I thought that you couldn't teach an old dog new tricks but I have learned new tricks. We all just love people for who they are here. It just makes me smile coming here. Also the food is good."



CASE MANAGEMENT

The quiet of a summer evening in Sun Prairie was shattered by an explosion that took the life of a Sun Prairie firefighter and left numerous people homeless. Some of those displaced were seniors and came to the Colonial Club for support. Gail, lead case manager worked diligently throughout the summer with several clients, as well as city officials and colleagues at SunShine Place. Gail was able to secure permanent housing for Sandy. To say Sandy was pleased is an understatement: "I'm not a youngster anymore and never thought I would have to start over. Having the support and assistance from Gail as much as I did was wonderful. She was helpful in so many ways with resources and even providing physical help to many, many amenities that I would need and didn't even think of. She helped get me headed in the right direction. I am happy, happy, happy."
