

Ralph began receiving case management services in February. Ralph had no income and only \$80 left in the bank. He was unable to pay his apartment rent and feared becoming homeless. He also was unable to afford groceries and was therefore, not eating nutritious meals. Working with his Colonial Club case manager and his advocate from the Aging & Disability Resource Center of Dane County, Ralph was able to secure an income through Social Security and began receiving nutritious meals through from the Colonial Club home delivered meal program.

The following month his case manager found an affordable low-income apartment and Ralph filled out the needed paperwork. Two volunteers offered their help and repaired a few things in his apartment prior to Ralph moving out. The same two volunteers then helped him load his belongings into their own vehicles and moved him to his new apartment on March 30, 2017.

Ralph is very happy with his situation and is very grateful for all the services and assistance he received.
